Fire Emergency Procedures

In the event of a fire alarm, all occupants of university buildings are required to:

1. **EVACUATE** the building
and
2. **REPORT** to the proper evacuation area.

Key Points For Fire Safety:

- Before evacuation,
 - **Shut down** all lab equipment/ procedures involving heated reactions.
 - For **LPM** and **LOG**, shut down per procedure.
 - **Close** all doors behind you.
- Always **use the stairs**. Never use an elevator in an evacuation.
- Assist **mobility-impaired** persons to stairwell and notify Tucson Fire Department of their locations.
- You must evacuate to at least 50 feet from the building, to the **designated evacuation area** at the North end of the parking lot.
- You cannot return to the building in question until the UAPD has signaled "**all clear**" in the designated evacuation area.
